## Consultation response to Review to SNH Visual Representation of Wind Farms

Though out with the consultation period we wish to make a further comment which we hope you will accept.

We have just had the opportunity of looking at a paper copy of an Environmental Statement for a current wind farm application.

The volume of Figures and Visualisations weighs 3 kg. There are 23 viewpoints represented by visualisations/photomontages and some wireframes. To take the volume on a visit round the view points and consider the visualisations on site in a methodological manner would be impossible.

A practical solution would be if applicants were advised to put visualisations in a separate volume. This would be a very real help to planners, landscape architects and others assessing the visual impact of the proposal on site.
